Scenario One	Actions	Communications
A staff member responds " yes " to one of the health screening questions, has a temperature of 100.4 or above, and/or exhibits symptoms of COVID-19.	 Staff: sent home (stay home if sick) Contact immediate Supervisor & Health Coordinator Contact HR The cohort remains OPEN. 	No action is needed
Scenario Two	Actions	Communications
A family member or someone in close contact with a student or staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Close contact defined as being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more.	 Staff: report information to administrator, sent home, self-quarantine for 14 calendar days since last exposure Exposed person contacts their healthcare provider for additional guidance The cohort remains OPEN. 	No action is needed
Scenario Three	Actions	Communications
Student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19.	 Staff: report information to administrator and the Monterey County Health Department. Positive individual self-isolates for at least 10 days from onset of symptoms or date of specimen collection Families of student/staff member: quarantine for 14 calendar days from last contact with infectious person The cohort is CLOSED for 14 days from last exposure or as determined by Monterey County Health Department. 	 To: Student Families and Staff Phone call and Template Letter: Confirmed COVID-19 in Classroom Template Letter: Follow-up Confirmed COVID-19 in Classroom

Scenario Four	Actions	Communications
Student or staff member tests negative for COVID-19 after any of the reasons in scenarios 1, 2, or 3	 Staff: May return to classroom 3 days after symptoms resolve or per their medical provider's direction, however must continue self-quarantine for 14 days if in close contact with person diagnosed with COVID-19. The cohort remains OPEN. 	No action is needed
Scenario Five	Actions	Communications
Student or staff member travel (International)	 Follow current CDC guidance for returning international travelers (currently 14 day self-quarantine) The cohort remains OPEN. 	No action is needed
Scenario Six	Actions	Communications
Other	 Student/staff is to self-monitor, self-screen for symptoms Practice preventive measures such as: Handwashing Use of hand sanitizer at least 60% alcohol Wearing of face mask/face covering 6ft social distancing If symptoms change, follow appropriate above scenario The cohort remains OPEN. 	No action is needed
